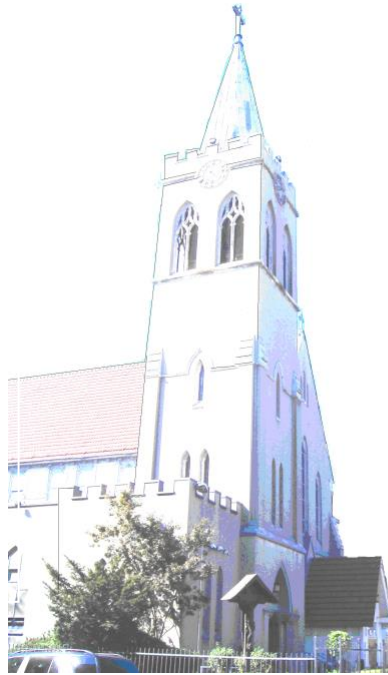

SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING - Nov. 21, 2021

In the 2nd Reading, Rev. 1.5-8, we hear:

*“Jesus Christ is the Faithful Witness, the firstborn of the dead
and the Ruler of the kings of the earth.*

*To Him Who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His Blood,
Who has made us into a kingdom of priests for His God and Father,
to Him be glory and power forever and ever.!”*

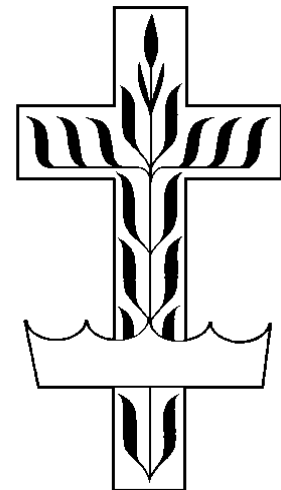
In John 18.33-37, Jesus says to Pilate:

*“My kingdom does not belong
to this world...*

as it is, My Kingdom is not here...

*For this I was born and
for this I came into the world,
to testify to the truth.*

*Everyone who belongs to the truth,
hears My voice.”*



CHRIST THE KING

The Church goes through a **cycle** every year. The cycle begins with **Advent**. We then go through the entire **Life of Christ - Christmas, Lent, Holy Week, Easter, Ascension, Pentecost**. That takes about half of the year. Then for the other half of the year, we celebrate the **teachings of Jesus for life in grace**. The whole cycle comes to an end with the great **Feast of Christ the King**, which we celebrate today - the last Sunday of the Church year.

Let's look at this Feast in terms of the **past, present and future**, for Jesus is the same **yesterday, today and tomorrow**.

THE PAST

In the Old Testament, after the Babylonian exile (around 600 BC), no more kings sat on the throne of David. Prophets began to prophesy that God would send a **king of the line of David, God's Anointed One**. This is the *promise of the Messiah*. The word *Messiah* is Hebrew for *Anointed One*. In Greek, the word is translated *Christos*. So, when you say that Jesus is the **Christ**, you believe that He is the Anointed King foretold in the Old Testament.



God has made him the head over all things for the church.
Eph. 1:22

THE PRESENT

Jesus preached about God's Kingdom - not a physical kingdom, but a spiritual reality. Those who serve Him, who seek His justice and peace, who cooperate in love to build a world as Jesus wants it, a world of brotherhood, faith and mercy -live **now** in the **Kingdom**. You live in the **Kingdom** if you serve **Jesus the King**. Let Jesus reign in your heart.

THE FUTURE

The world as we know it will pass away. Do not put your hopes on it. In the end, all things will be subjected to Jesus the Christ (the King). He will establish His rule over all Creation. The Church longs for that day, when Jesus returns in glory, when He establishes a kingdom of peace, of love and of justice. When we see the world turn wicked around us, we lose hope. Have courage - **Jesus is forever victorious!**

LE CHRIST-ROI

L'Église parcourt un **cycle** chaque année. Le cycle commence avec **l'Avent**. Puis on passe pour toute la **Vie du Christ - Noël, Carême, la Semaine Sainte, la Pâque, l'Ascension, la Pentecôte**. Tout cela dure presque la moitié de l'année. Puis pendant l'autre moitié, nous célébrons les **enseignements de Jésus pour la vie dans la grâce**. Le cycle entier arrive à sa fin avec la grande **Fête du Christ-Roi**, laquelle nous célébrons aujourd'hui - le dernier Dimanche de l'Année de l'Église.

Considérons cette Fête en termes **du passé, du présent et du futur**, car Jésus est le même **hier, aujourd'hui et demain**.

LE PASSÉ

Dans l'Ancien Testament, après l'Exile en Babylone (vers 600 av JC), il n'y avait plus des rois assis sur le trône de David. Les Prophètes ont commencé à prédire que Dieu enverrait un **roi de la lignée de David, le Oint de Dieu**. Celle-ci est la *promesse du Messie*. La parole *Messie* est Hébreu pour *l'Oint*. En Grec, on transmet la parole par *Christos*. Ainsi, en disant que Jésus est le **Christ**, on professe qu'Il est le Roi sur qui reste l'Onction de

LE PRÉSENT

Dieu comme prédit par la Bible ésus a prêché sur le Royaume de Dieu - non pas un royaume matériel, sinon une réalité spirituelle. CRISTO REY

La Iglesia pasa por un **ciclo** cada año. El ciclo comienza con el **Adviento**. Pues pasamos por toda la **Vida de Cristo - Navidad, Cuaresma, la Semana Santa, Pascua, Ascensión, Pentecostés**. Todo eso toma casi la mitad del año. Pues por la otra mitad del año, celebramos las **enseñanzas de Jesús para la vida en la gracia**. El ciclo entero llega a su fin con la gran **Fiesta de Cristo Rey**, la cual celebramos hoy - el último Domingo del Año de la Iglesia.

Consideremos esta Fiesta en términos **del pasado, del presente y del futuro**, porque Jesús es el Mismo **ayer, hoy y mañana**.

EL PASADO

En el Antiguo Testamento, después del Exilio en Babilonia (como 600 años antes de JC), no había más reyes en el trono de David. Profetas comenzaron a predecir que Dios enviaría un **rey del linaje de David, el Ungido de Dios**. Ésta es la *promesa del Mesías*. La palabra *Mesías* es hebreo para el *Ungido*. En griego, se transmite esta palabra por *Christos*. Por eso, al decir que Jesús es el **Cristo**, uno cree que Él es el Rey Ungido predicho por el Antiguo Testamento.
